Announcements - Week 10 of Distance Learning

1 Week left before the start of Hybrid Learning! - Please click <u>here</u> to see the new Hybrid & Remote Learning Bell Schedule. Please check your student email to find out which cohort you are!

Hybrid starts Mon/Tues (11/9-11/10) for **Cohort A** and <u>Thur/Fri (11/12-11/13)</u> for **Cohort B**. When returning in person, here are some important items for you to review:

- In Person/On Campus Essentials: When you are on campus, please make sure you bring your Chromebook, Chromebook charger, water bottle, lanyard, ID, face covering and, for speciality classroom environments, a face shield.
- **Personal Protection Items:** Each student will receive two cloth face coverings on the first day of school, as well as a face shield for specialized classroom settings such as science labs, ceramics, or career tech education courses.
- Face covering requirement: Students will be required to wear a face mask at all times except when eating. Students will be provided 2 warnings if their face coverings are not worn properly. If a student continues to defy the requirement, they will no longer be able to participate in in-person learning.
- Lanyards for IDs: Each student will be issued a lanyard in order to display their student ID at all times. This serves two purposes: so staff can more quickly identify students and provide quicker access for touch free scanning in the nutrition, library, and ASB purchase lines.
- Requirement to have Zoom camera on: Up to this point students have been permitted to choose whether or not to turn their camera on during Zoom sessions. PYLUSD feels that this has been detrimental to student engagement. As a result, students will be required to have their cameras on during Zoom sessions. If you have a concern about this requirement, please contact your counselor.
- Consistent seating charts: Teachers will be assigning seating in their classes that will remain in place for the remainder of the semester in order to help with contact tracing if someone is diagnosed with COVID-19.
- **Water bottles:** Since refillable bottle hydration stations will be the only way to access drinking water, each school has purchased water bottles or cups for students who do not have their own.
- Check for understanding periods: The check for understanding periods will be cancelled during the week of November 2-6. Teachers will use these afternoons to prepare the physical environment and technology in their classrooms in preparation for hybrid instruction.

If you still need to pick up items at school, you can come to our **Back to School Registration Days Part 2** today-Wednesday (11/2-11/4) from 2-4 pm. Please enter through front gates and follow the signs.

- **Parking Permit** Cost \$10. Students need to bring their driver's license and know the license plate number & make/model of the car. Click here for form.
