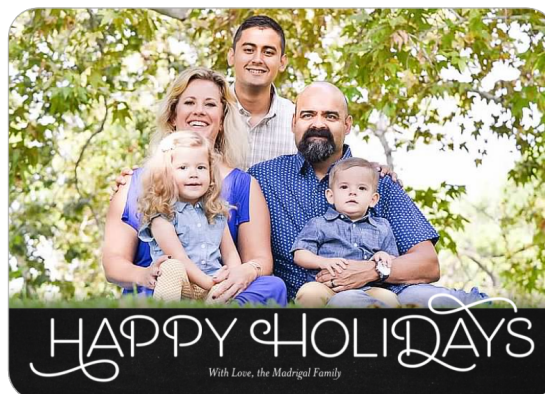
- Donate a used TI-84 graphing calculator
