Parents/Students - It is the policy of PYLUSD that students maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average and be passing 20 credits to be **eligible to participate in co-curricular activities**. Academic ineligibility affects all extracurricular and co-curricular activities including, but not limited to: athletics, cheer/song, dance team, band, orchestra, choir, academic competition teams, and clubs. For first quarter reporting, PYLUSD has extended the suspension of traditional eligibility criteria. During the 2021 first quarter, the following criteria applies:

Ineligible means the student has earned less than 20 credits. An "F" grade means no class credit. Ineligible students may participate during their designated class period only, but may not compete or participate in any activities that occur after the school day. In addition, students are not allowed to attend any field trips.

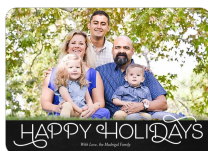
Probation means the student slipped below a 2.0 for this grading period. There are no restrictions on activities, but please encourage your student to keep up their grades to avoid Ineligibility the next grading period.

For the purpose of this policy, grading periods are: 1st quarter, 1st semester, 3rd quarter, and 2nd semester. Letters will be sent home in the next few weeks to students that are ineligible or on probation. If you have any questions, please contact the student's counselor.

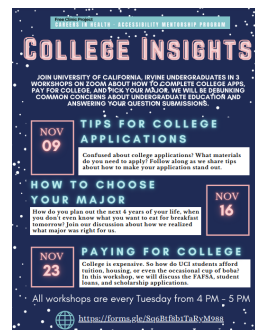
