SENIORS....this is your last week! YEAH! Here are some important announcements for you:

- Please pick up your **Class of 2021 EDHS mask** for graduation and **7 tickets** to the ceremony beginning Thursday, June 10, in the Activities Office. Remote students, please pick up yours after school in the Activities Office.
- Graduation is at Bradford Stadium on June 16 starting promptly at 5:00 pm. Arrive no later than 4:15 pm. Gates to the stadium will open at 3:30 pm. There is handicap seating available on both sides of the stadium in the bleachers and along the track. There is no need to reserve spots for handicap seating. We encourage all graduates to exit the field immediately to see friends and family for photos. No guests are allowed onto the field at any time. PLEASE refrain from air horns as they drown out the names of other graduates.
- Graduation rehearsal is also June 16 and is important to the flow and success of the ceremony. Seniors should be early to rehearsal. Please arrive at the gym at Valencia no later than 10:45 am. Do not wear your cap and gown to rehearsal.
- Grad Night is officially SOLD OUT! If your student purchased a Grad Night ticket, we will be distributing t-shirts and collecting any missing paperwork on Wed, June 9th from 2-3 pm in front of the marquee. Emails will be sent to anyone who is missing necessary paperwork. Students are welcome to wear their shirts to Grad Night. Grad Night is <u>June 16th</u>. We strongly encourage students not to leave their cars in the parking lot. EDHS PTSA and EDHS are not responsible for any damages or theft.
