

## Ready, Set, Register!

#### Attention Grades 9-11th

Counselors have been out to all the classrooms presenting registration materials that students will need to register for next year's classes. Here are some useful tools to help you:

- 1. Access the <u>Online Registration Instructions</u> and start thinking about classes to take.
- 2. Watch the Online Course Request Video
- 3. Communicate with your teachers/parents to discuss the most appropriate classes to take.
- 4. Enter your course requests in Aeries (follow the Online Registration Instructions) this is how you register! If you skip this step, you won't have classes for next year!
- 5. Note: zero period starts at 7:16 AM

Deadline to enter course requests in Aeries:

11th Graders = March 5th 10th Graders = March 12th 9th Graders = March 21st

#### What happens if you missed the FAFSA deadline?

If you missed the FAFSA deadline of March 2nd, you may not be eligible to access some forms of financial aid for that academic year. Some states and colleges continue to award aid to FAFSA latecomers, but your chances get much slimmer, and the payout is often lower. For FAFSA, there is the end-of-June federal deadline of June 30th, so please apply if you haven't submitted your application! You can also pursue alternative routes such as scholarships, private loans and grants or you can contact your college or look into state or local financial aid programs for assistance.

Mike Oberle Scholarship - Mr. Oberle (Obe) taught Chemistry and AP Physics, coached OCAD, and served as technology support for most of his 30 years at EDHSI. He was also a graduate of EDHS, involved in water polo and swimming. 
