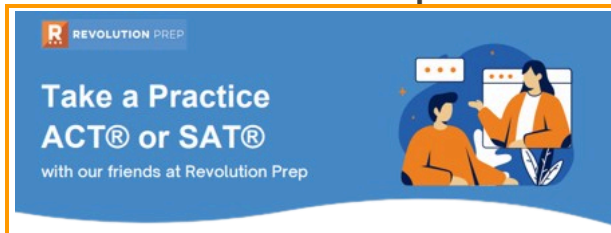

PSAT/MNST Digital Exam @ EDHS - Although the SAT is optional for UC's and Cal State colleges, more and more schools are starting to require test scores. By taking the PSAT, Juniors can be entered into the National Merit Scholarship competition and be eligible for more college scholarships based on their SAT score. Sophomores benefit as well by practicing the digital version of the PSAT and trying to improve their scores. The PSAT will be held at EDHS on Saturday, Oct. 12th, 7:45 -12 pm, open to 10th & 11th grades only. Deadline to register is Sept. 3rd, 2pm. Cost is \$45, paid at the Finance Office.
