Dress Code Policy

The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to ensure a safe and orderly educational environment for all students. Students are expected to demonstrate responsible behavior that does not interfere with the safety, well-being or educational opportunities for themselves or others.

Examples of items not allowed include:

- **PLAYBOY** (any reference to parody)
- **WEAPON** (any reference to display or possession)
- **WEAPON** (any reference to display or possession)

When fashion trends come about that compromise the learning environment or safety of our students, Administration reserves the right to adjust the dress code accordingly without prior notice.

Disciplinary consequences may include:

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

Athletic co-curricular activities generally take place outside of regular classroom hours and serve as an extension of the academic curriculum. These activities include, but are not limited to:

- Athletic teams
- Dance teams
- Cheer squads
- Song squads

Academic Requirements

All student-athletes must be passing a minimum of 20 units. Students who fail to meet this requirement will be **immediately ineligible**, with no probation period. To ensure eligibility, student-athletes are strongly encouraged to enroll in **at least five classes per semester**.

Student-athletes must also maintain a minimum **unweighted grade point average (GPA) of 2.0** (1 "C" average) on a 4.0 scale. If a student fails to meet the 2.0 GPA requirement at the end of a grading period, the student will be placed on **academic probation** for one grading period.

If the student does not earn a 2.0 GPA by the conclusion of the probationary period, the student will be **deemed ineligible** to participate in co-curricular athletic programs. Eligibility may be restored once the student achieves a minimum 2.0 GPA at the end of a subsequent grading period.

The grading periods referenced in this policy include:
1st Quarter, 1st Semester, 3rd Quarter, and 2nd Semester
