#### ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

Athletic co-curricular activities generally take place outside of regular classroom hours and serve as an extension of the academic curriculum. These activities include, but are not limited to:

- Athletic teams
- Dance teams
- Cheer squads
- Song squads

**Academic Requirements**

All student-athletes must be passing a minimum of **20 units**. Students who fail to meet this requirement will be **immediately ineligible**, with no probation period. To ensure eligibility, student-athletes are strongly encouraged to enroll in **at least five classes per semester**.

Student-athletes must also maintain a minimum **unweighted grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 ("C" average)** on a 4.0 scale. If a student fails to meet the 2.0 GPA requirement at the end of a grading period, the student will be placed on **academic probation** for one grading period.

If the student does not earn a 2.0 GPA by the conclusion of the probationary period, the student will be **deemed ineligible** to participate in co-curricular athletic programs. Eligibility may be restored once the student achieves a minimum 2.0 GPA at the end of a subsequent grading period.

The grading periods referenced in this policy include:  
**1st Quarter, 1st Semester, 3rd Quarter, and 2nd Semester**
