Students will take college classes towards earning a school age certificate or a California teacher permit while gaining relevant work experience.

WHICH PATH IS RIGHT FOR YOU?

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (ECEAP)

- Work with young children (6 months – 5 years)
- Earn your California Child Development Teacher Permit
- Gain experience in Rancho Santiago Community College District early childhood centers
- 18-month apprenticeship

BILINGUAL EDUCATOR APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM (BEAP)

- Work with school-age children (5 years – 12 years)
- Earn the SAC After School Program Associate Teacher Certificate
- Gain experience in SAUSD's Engage 360° after-school programs
- 24-month apprenticeship

REQUIREMENTS TO JOIN:

- Legal right to work in the United States
- Be at least 18 years old
- High school diploma or equivalent

- Government-issued ID
- Required immunizations
- Health screening/ TB assessment
