- I understand that if I am selected by the Judging Committee, I will have several required rehearsals prior to graduation. I understand that if I miss these rehearsals, my privilege to give the graduation address may be revoked.
- **I REALIZE THAT THE JUDGES AND/OR MR. CAMPUZANO AND/OR THE ADMINISTRATION MAY HAVE CHANGES FOR MY SPEECH, AND I WILL OPENLY AND WILLINGLY ENGAGE IN A THOROUGH REVISION AND EDITING PROCESS.**
- I understand that if I should change any of the content of my speech during the address, administrative action may be taken and I may face disciplinary consequences.
- I know that the administration will have a copy of my speech and have the right to stop the address if anything is in violation of the prepared presentation.
- I agree that if I am not selected by the Judging Committee, I will provide support and encouragement to the students who are selected to be the speakers at the Graduation Ceremony.

GUIDELINES

YOUR SPEECH MUST:

- **Have a title**
- Be YOUR ORIGINAL WORK – we want to hear YOUR VOICE and YOUR THOUGHTS.
- No longer than 3 minutes
- Delivered with clarity, confidence and eye contact
- Representative, relevant, and captivating – what would someone at YOUR time and place in history think RIGHT NOW?
- What particular challenges face YOU and those around you?
- What moments capture YOUR high school experience?
- Show that you can THINK OUTSIDE THE BOX. You are an original voice – show it to us.
- Typewritten and double-spaced at the time of your audition (bring 5-6 copies) and accompanied by your signed speaker contract, unless your contract was previously submitted
- One that you are not so committed to that you are not willing to edit, cut, and amend it if we feel that is necessary.
- Your speech DOES NOT need to be memorized.
